
WHO

Once completed, the food items are donated to the food bank for distribution to those in need.

The judging categories include: Best Meal, Best Use of Labels, Structural Ingenuity, Jurors' Favorite, Honorable Mention, People's Choice and Most Food Used. Once your Canstruction project is built, judges will visit your location to judge your sculpture. Please join this fun, creative, and friendly Canstruction competition.

A few friendly reminders: Teams are responsible for their own cans and non-perishable food items (please no damaged goods), any adhesives used should be easily removable and structures should be ready to be judged the week of September 28 at your location!
